Little Tykes Demolition Derby

Event Details:

The 2019 Little Tykes Demo Derby will be held Sunday June 9, 2018 at the Manitoba Summer Fair Demolition Derby grounds, during the halftime break (Approx 2:30pm). All drivers must be on site by 11am for inspection, registration and photos. Kids will compete in power wheel vehicles to smash (aka pop balloons) other derby participants to take home the title of Winner.

General Rules:

1. Kids 4-10 years of age may participate in two different age groups 4-6 and 7-10. Ages as of December 31, 2019
2. Registration per driver is \$ 20.00 includes ONE free adult admission with each entry.
3. Everyone must pre-enter by June 4, 2018.
4. Each heat will be given a time limit. If at the end of the heat, there is more than one contestant with balloons un-popped, heat will be declared a tie.
5. If a child gets out of the power wheel during the event, that child is disqualified.

Power Wheels Building Rules:

1. Any regular 6 or 12-volt electric Power Wheel is allowed. NO 4-wheeler or tractor type vehicle allowed. Child's legs must be in the compartment. Ride in not ride on!
2. Helmets must be worn. A bicycle helmet is ok.
3. Seatbelts are recommended.
4. NO PASSENGERS
5. Motors must remain stock. *Batteries may be changed out, but NOTHING larger than a 12-volt lawn and garden battery. ABSOLUTELY NO CAR BATTERIES.
6. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties or duct tape or other flexible product for making them stay shut.
7. Stock Tires Only. Tires may be covered with duct tape to prevent them from cracking or breaking. No screws in tires, no chains, etc.
8. Decorative changes can be made to the Power Wheel to make it look like a derby car, however; there can be no reinforcement to the power wheel. Changes and additions are only decorative.
9. At all times remember this is for kids!! Don't add something that could cause them not to be in the derby. You could have a disappointed child if not allowed to run.
10. All power wheels will be checked in at pit gate then impounded until time for their event.
11. One parent will be allowed on the track with their child during the event.
12. 4 large balloons will be attached by fair. The object is to pop balloons. The last one left with a balloon is the winner.
13. If the vehicle has more than one speed, low speed must be used.

Parents, this is for fun ... please don't forget that. Teach your kids good sportsmanship!
